

- Reg. No. 10643 ex-Cst. Elmer Kitchen, 56, died Oct. 27, 1965 at Regina, Sask. Born June 24, 1909 at Avonlea, Sask., he joined the RCMP July 11, 1929 at Regina. He was invalided on Oct. 3, 1930. He had been stationed at Regina. During World War II he served overseas with the RCASC from Mar. 16, 1940 to Oct. 11, 1945.
- Ex-Spl. Cst. Rudolf Thorvald Johnsen, -90, died June 27, 1966 at Burnaby, B.C. He was born Oct. 14, 1875 at Copenhagen, Denmark, and joined the RCMP as a special constable Nov. 19, 1942 at Resolution, N.W.T. He joined the crew of the Schooner *St. Roch* as engineer at Lunenburg, N.S., on Dec. 11, 1942 and was aboard the vessel when it left Sydney, N.S., on July 26, 1944 on the start of her return voyage through the Northwest Passage, which terminated at Vancouver, B.C., on October 16 that year, and for which he received the Polar Medal. He was discharged from the Force Mar. 31, 1953 at the age of 77. In addition to serving aboard the *St. Roch*, Mr. Johnsen had been stationed at Ottawa, Ont., Spence Bay and Cambridge Bay, N.W.T.
- Reg. No. 12645 ex-Sgt. Fred Dobbs, 52, died May 28, 1966 at Fredericton, N.B. Born Oct. 22, 1913 at Grenfell, Sask., he joined the RCMP June 27, 1935 at Winnipeg, Man. He retired to pension on June 26, 1960 after serving 25 years, having accepted a position with the New Brunswick provincial government. He had been stationed at Winnipeg, Vancouver, B.C., Regina, Sask., Rockcliffe, Toronto and Sudbury, Ont., Montreal, Rock Island, Hemmingford and Huntingdon, Que., Grand Bank, Nfld., St. Stephen and Fredericton. Ex-Sergeant Dobbs was an excellent athlete and was the holder of the Black Belt in judo.
- Reg. No. 12449 ex-Cpl. Nathan Levi Casselman, 55, died June 1, 1966 at Toronto, Ont. He was born Mar. 27, 1911 at Berwick, Ont., and joined the RCMP "Marine" Section on Oct. 25, 1934 at Ottawa, Ont. He was discharged Sept. 30, 1939 upon being transferred to the Royal Canadian Navy for service during World War II. He rejoined the Force at Halifax, N.S., on Sept. 13, 1945 after being demobilized, and he retired to pension on Oct. 31, 1960, having served for 26 years. He had been stationed at Halifax, Charlottetown, P.E.I., Niagara Falls, Toronto, Sarnia and Windsor, Ont.
- Reg. No. 14398 ex-Cst. John Leslie Blair, 43, died Feb. 20, 1965 at Edmonton, Alta. He was born Sept. 12, 1922 at East Kildonan, Man., and joined the RCMP Jan. 9, 1942 at Winnipeg, Man. He purchased his discharge on Aug. 31, 1946. He had been stationed at Rockcliffe, Ont., Regina, Kelvington, Weyburn, Estevan and Gravelbourg, Sask.
- Reg. No. 12089 ex-Cst. Arthur Herbert Lucas, 59, died recently at Lancaster, N.B. He was born Dec. 21, 1906 at Saint John, N.B., and joined the RCMP Nov. 16, 1933 at Ottawa, Ont. He purchased his discharge on June 11, 1934. He had been stationed at Regina, Sask.
- Reg. No. 3556 ex-Cst. William Leonard Lawton, 88, died Sept. 17, 1965 at Vancouver, B.C. Born in July 1877 at Sparta, Ont., he joined the NWMP Apr. 3, 1900 at London, Ont. He took his discharge when his term expired on July 30, 1902. He had been stationed at Regina and Whitehorse, Y.T.
- Ex-Spl. Cst. Thomas McGill, 81, died Apr. 17, 1966 at Ottawa, Ont. He was born Mar. 8, 1885 in Scotland and joined the RCMP as a special constable Sept. 24, 1928 at Regina, Sask. He retired to pension on Nov. 30, 1952. All of his service was spent in "Depot" Division.
- Ex-Spl. Cst. Samuel Richard Maddick, 77, died Dec. 15, 1965 at Vancouver, B.C. He was born in August 1888 and joined the RCMP as a special constable guard at Vancouver on Oct. 21, 1941. He was discharged on Sept. 7, 1945. During World War I he served with the R.C.E. and the C.A.S.F. between 1915 and 1919.
- Ex-Spl. Cst. Chester Collison Marshall, 67, died Jan. 23, 1966 at Ottawa, Ont. He was born in May 1898 and joined the RCMP as a special constable guard at Ottawa on Nov. 5, 1940. He resigned on Nov. 30, 1942.
- Ex-Spl. Cst. Arnold Ogilvie Parsons, 72, died Aug. 4, 1965 at Regina, Sask. He was born June 8, 1893 at Newcastle-on-Tyne, England, and joined the RCMP as a special constable cook at Regina on Feb. 1, 1937. He resigned on Sept. 30, 1943.
- Reg. No. 12205 ex-Sgt. William Ralph Chandler, 73, died May 2, 1966 at Chester, N.S. He was born at Tancook Island, N.S., on Feb. 25, 1893 and joined the RCMP as a special constable in the "Marine" Section on May 16, 1933 at Halifax, N.S. He became a regular member (ordinary seaman) on Apr. 1, 1934. He was discharged on Sept. 30, 1939, having been transferred to the Royal Canadian Navy. He re-engaged in the Force at Halifax on Sept. 2, 1945 after being demobilized from the Navy, and he retired to pension on Aug. 8, 1949. During World War I he served in the RCN from Jan. 25, 1915 to Dec. 31, 1918.
